Carbon Monoxide Awareness

As we enter the colder months, it's crucial to raise awareness about a silent but deadly threat: carbon monoxide (CO). This <u>colorless</u>, <u>odorless</u> gas and can lead to serious health risks if not properly managed.

Why You Should Be Concerned: Health Risks: Exposure can cause symptoms ranging from headaches and dizziness to confusion and loss of consciousness. In high concentrations, it can even be fatal. **Sources of CO:** Common sources include gas appliances (furnaces and stoves), wood stoves, and generators. Even cars running in an enclosed space can produce dangerous levels of this gas.

Prevention Tips:

Install CO Detectors: Place detectors in key areas of your home, especially near sleeping areas, and test regularly.

Regular Maintenance: Have your heating systems and appliances inspected annually.

Ventilation: Ensure proper ventilation when using fuel-burning appliances.

What to Do in an Emergency:

If your CO detector goes off or you suspect carbon monoxide poisoning, immediately move to fresh air and call emergency services. Do not ignore these warnings!
